Action Taken Report for Feedback Analysis Report Prepared by the IQAC for the Academic Session 2019-20

Introduction:

The improvement of quality in educational institutions is mostly dependent on feedback mechanisms that furnish perspectives from many stakeholders. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) gathers and evaluates input from students, parents, employers, alumni, and teachers on various issues related to the teaching-learning mechanism. These viewpoints provide insights for enhancing a variety of aspects of the college setting, such as medium and effectiveness of instruction, curricula, facilities, general atmosphere, and employment opportunities. Based on the insights gleaned from the feedback report, the following actions were taken to address the identified areas of improvement.

Teachers' Performance:

While most respondents appreciate the dedication and proficiency of faculty members, certain individuals require further development. As indicated in the feedback report, certain students expressed dissatisfaction with specific departments regarding less number of ICT classes as well as special classes addressing the examination related questions. In a confidential meeting, the Principal discreetly shared these evaluations with the faculty members, ensuring utmost anonymity. Those faculty members in need of improvement were apprised of the challenges. The concerned departments were communicated to take special classes, remedial classes, as and when necessary to help the students prepare for the university examinations. The Coordinator of IQAC was also requested by the Principal to organize Faculty Development Programmes so that the faculty members could learn about the cutting-edge technology and use those in their day-to-day teaching.

Curriculum:

Feedback from students, teachers, and other stakeholders indicates that the curriculum has been successful in generating interest among students, thereby fostering a vibrant and engaging learning environment. The Principal communicated the faculty members to continue to prioritize

Infrastructure:

Feedback from students, teachers and other stakeholders revealed an overall satisfaction with the amenities provided by the college. However, some areas of improvement were noted by the Principal regarding the beautification of the campus and purchase of more books for the library. The Principal made sure that concerned persons were communicated for the said purpose.

College Atmosphere:

Additional endeavors to foster student participation, cultural events, and community engagement will be pursued to enhance the liveliness and supportive nature of the campus.
