(i) Expansion of Library Resources:

(ii) Integration of Resources on Career Counseling:

The members decided to procure books specifically focused on career counseling, enhancing the availability of resources that guide and support students in making informed decisions about their academic and professional paths.

(iii) Enhanced Integration of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in Classes:

Recognizing the importance of technology in education, the members decided to increase the incorporation of ICT in classes.

(iv) Provision of Notes:

The members resolved to provide more notes to the students.

The meeting started with the Principal, Purbasthali College, Dr. Bibhas Chandra Saha, on the chair. In the beginning, the minutes of the last meeting was read and confirmed unanimously. It was reported that the Principal had started the process of registering the Alumni Association of the College.

Regarding the second agenda, after a long discussion the members of the committee resolved the following:

(i) Orienting students regarding teaching-learning processes

The members resolved that a Orientation/ Ice-breaking session would be conducted for the newly admitted students to familiarize the students with the pedagogical methods, curriculum, and resources available to them.

(ii) Feedbacks to be taken

Feedbacks from all the stakeholders would be taken to solicit input from students, faculties, employers regarding the academic performance and overall college ambience.

(iii) Preparatory Tests, Module, Academic Calendar

The members resolved that preparing students adequately for academic assessments was crucial for enhancing learning outcomes and performance, and for that preparatory tests would serve as effective tools for assessing students' understanding of course materials and identifying areas for improvement, thus, Preparatory Tests shall be taken to provide students with an opportunity to review and reinforce their learning. It was also decided that Departmental modules and academic calendar would be created and circulated to the students.

(iv) Orientation of library

The members recognized the importance of enhancing sustainability measures and improving access to resources for the betterment of the institution, and that effective library orientation play a crucial role in empowering users to navigate library services efficiently, fostering a culture of research, and promoting academic excellence; they requested the Librarian to implement a comprehensive library orientation program for all incoming students, faculty, and staff.

(v) Rain water harvesting

It was resolved unanimously that rainwater harvesting would present an opportunity to mitigate water scarcity, reduce environmental impact, and promote responsible water management practices within the institution; thus, the institute would undertake a feasibility study to assess the viability of rainwater harvesting systems on campus. Upon approval, implementation plans shall be developed to install rainwater harvesting infrastructure in key locations across the campus. Awareness campaigns shall be conducted to educate the campus community about the importance of rainwater harvesting and encourage participation in water conservation efforts. The Principal was authorized by the committee to take up this matter.

(vi) Establishment of Compost pit

It was decided that implementing compost pits would align with the commitment of the institute to environmental sustainability by utilizing the biodegradable waste, enriching soil fertility, and promoting eco-friendly waste management solutions; therefore, the Green and Clean Campus Committee was informed to look into the matter.

(vii) Sanitary Napkin vending Machine

The members recognized the importance of promoting menstrual hygiene and ensuring access to sanitary products for the students, and that access to sanitary napkins was essential for the health, well-being, and dignity of individuals who menstruate, and providing convenient access to these products would contribute to creating a supportive and inclusive campus environment; the members unanimously supported the idea of installation of Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine in the Girls' Common Room.

(viii) Installation of Solar Panel

The members recognized the importance of using sustainable energy practices and reducing the carbon footprint of the institution, and harnessing solar energy through the installation of solar panels would present an opportunity to reduce dependency on non-renewable energy sources, lower energy costs, and contribute to environmental conservation efforts; and that the adoption of solar energy would align with the institution's commitment to sustainability, innovation, and responsible resource management; therefore, it was resolved unanimously that solar panels would be established in the campus. The Principal was authorized by the committee to take up the matter.

(ix) Research to be Strengthened

It was decided that fostering a culture of research was integral to the academic excellence and intellectual growth of the institution, and for that initiatives would be taken to strengthen research endeavors across disciplines. The research committee was informed to motivate the faculty members for conducting researches.

Regarding the third agenda, it was decided that IQAC would conduct a "Workshop on NAAC Accrediation" on August 08, 2022 in which Dr. Subhas Singha Ray, Associate Professor, and IQAC Coordinator, Chandidas Mahavidyalaya would conduct the workshop. IQAC would also organize a Special Lecture on "NAAC Evaluation Process" by Prof. Apurba Ratan Ghosh on August 20, 2022.

Regarding the fourth agenda, the members while discussing about the significance of faculty development initiatives in enhancing teaching effectiveness, promoting academic excellence, and fostering a deeper understanding of educational policies and reforms, talked about the importance of the National Education Policy 2020 that would come into effect in near future, and the need for organizing a FDP on the above mentioned topic which would provide an opportunity for faculty members to familiarize themselves with the key principles, objectives, and implementation strategies of the policy, enabling them to align their teaching practices and curriculum development efforts with the new educational paradigm. Thus, it was decided that a One-Week Faculty Development Programme on "National Education Policy 2020" would be conducted from June 03-10, 2022 by the IQAC.

After deliberating on the scheduled agenda, the members felt the significance of aligning institutional policies, practices, and academic programs with the objectives and principles outlined in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, and the need for establishing a dedicated "NEP Committee". It was unanimously decided that the committee would comprise of Dr. Sukla Bhattacharyya (Convener), Mr. Anupam Das, Dr. Suchandra Neogi, Dr. Lipika Ghoshal, Dr. Soumya Mohan Ghosh, Dr. Ashes Datta, Mr. Aniruddha Debnath, and Mr. Nirmal Das. The NEP Committee shall be entrusted with the following responsibilities:

- Study and analyze the key provisions, objectives, and recommendations outlined in the NEP 2020 document;
- Assess the implications of the NEP 2020 on the institution's vision, mission, goals, and academic programs;
- Develop strategies and action plans for aligning institutional policies, practices, and curriculum frameworks with the principles and goals of the NEP 2020;
- Facilitate capacity-building initiatives, workshops, and seminars to raise awareness and promote understanding of the NEP 2020 among faculty, staff, and students;
- Monitor the progress of NEP-related initiatives, evaluate their impact, and provide recommendations for continuous improvement.

The committee shall be accountable for the effective implementation of NEP-related initiatives and the achievement of established goals and targets.
